Dear Parents and Students,

The Foodservice Department at San Carlos Unified School District recently purchased a new Point of Sale (POS) system for the cafeteria. This new system will assist us in increasing the level of service we provide, as well as generate accurate school meal counts. We are currently preparing to implement this new system in our district on October 8, 2019

For cafeteria items, such as ala carte, water bottles etc. students will continue to use their current ID number or Student ID card. Please note that serving lines may be slower for the first couple of days with the new POS system, but as the students familiarize themselves with the system the lines should move much more quickly.

To fund your student's account, we recommend parents/guardians deposit money using cash or check payments. You can also use MySchoolBucks.com to receive low balance alerts, set up automatic payments, and set daily/weekly spending limits.

Funds that remain in your student's meal account at the end of the school year will be carried over to the next school year. Please note that if your student's meal account runs out of funds we do not extend credit.

Your student has qualified for free meals this information is noted in the system and the meal will be processed just as it is for all other students without any special indication to other students.

If your student has any allergies or other medical concerns, please notify us so this information can be placed in the system. This will alert our staff to help monitor their meals.
